Varicocele Embolisation: A Safe and Effective Treatment



What is Varicocele?

A varicocele is an enlargement of veins within the scrotum, similar to varicose veins in the legs. It can lead to discomfort and pain and, in a few cases, contribute to infertility.

Symptoms and Causes

- Symptoms: Dull pain, testicular discomfort, a feeling of heaviness, and, in some cases, infertility.
- Causes: Often due to faulty valves in the veins that lead to blood pooling and vein enlargement.




Traditional vs. Non-Surgical Treatments

- Traditional Treatments: Surgery was once the main option, requiring incisions and extended recovery.
- ✓ Non-Surgical Option Varicocele Embolisation: A minimally invasive treatment that uses a tiny coil or agent to block blood flow to the affected veins, offering effective relief without surgery.

Varicocele Embolisation Explained

A catheter is inserted into the neck vein, and a small coil or embolic agent is placed to block the blood flow in the varicocele veins, causing them to shrink over time.




Benefits of Embolisation

- ✓ Minimally Invasive: Performed through a tiny incision; no stitches required.
- ✓ Quick Recovery: Patients generally return to normal activities within days.
- ✓ Effective Symptom Relief: Reduces pain and improves fertility outcomes.

The Procedure: What to Expect

- ✓ Preparation: Consultation and imaging ensure correct diagnosis.
- ✓ During the Procedure: Local anaesthesia is administered, and a catheter is inserted to guide the embolic agent to the varicocele.
- ✓ Time: Approximately 1–2 hours.



Post-Procedure Care and Recovery

- ✓ Immediate Recovery: Some mild discomfort may occur, but it is managed with pain relievers.
- Long-Term Care: Patients can resume normal activities soon, with a follow-up to monitor recovery.

Comparing Embolisation to Surgery

- ✓ Embolisation: Minimally invasive with faster recovery.
- ✓ Surgery: Requires incision in the neck area and longer downtime.
